

The 4th Student Literary Competition

excellence in writing in English.



Eligibility:

The competition is open to all undergraduate students (BA studies) and graduate students (MA studies) registered during the 2017-2018 academic year in the Institute of English Studies.

Description:

You may submit your work within one of the general categories: short fiction, non-fiction, drama and poetry, as well as song lyrics. You may enter one work in each category.

There is no themed category for submissions.

The text must be in English.

Each entry must reflect the contestant's own work and original writing.

Guidelines:

Entries must be unpublished. Manuscripts must be typed and printed out.

To ensure peer review of your work, your name must not appear anywhere on the document; however, the title of the work must appear on each page of the manuscript.

Along with the text you should enclose a separate cover sheet with your name and email address.

Deadlines and Judging:

You may submit your entry to the secretary of the Institute of English Studies, room C-942.

The deadline is **May 7th 2018**.

The jury consists of Competition Coordinator, dr. Urszula Niewiadomska-Flis, and dr. Łukasz Borowiec, Jury member.

Recognition of winners:

All competition participants will be notified by email about the results.

The official acknowledgement of the winner will also be posted on IFA webpage.

Winning entries will be nominated for the Chancellor's award and will also receive a prize (in the form of a book) from the Institute of English Studies.
