II INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPETITION

The Organisers

Objectives

- Motivating students to improve their English language skills.
- Broadening the students' knowledge of their own town and region.
- Enhancing students' creativity and promoting their achievements.
- Promoting young artistic talents.

The Participants

- Students from Poland and abroad, Students from Polish schools abroad

divided into two age categories:

Category 1 – students aged 6-9.

Category 2 – students aged 10-13.

Rules of participation

1. Students create a project in English – an album called 'My town'.
2. The aim of the project is to present the students' city or town in a written and graphical form.
3. The album should contain at least six A4 pages.
4. Students design the layout in a free painting technique (acrylic, watercolor, dry or oil pastel, pencil, ink drawing, etc.).
5. The work should be performed individually. The spacial works, of group authorship, rolled up or devastated will not be taken into consideration.

6. The maximum number of participants from the same school is two students - one in each category only.
 7. The projects should be submitted in person or sent by mail to the address of the Władysław Broniewski Primary School No. 25 in Lublin, by 26 January 2018.
 8. The cost of the delivery is covered by the sender.
 9. The filled-in Participant's Card must be submitted along with the project.
10. The projects will be assessed by the competition board. The board's decisions are final.
1. The assessment criteria: the content and language correctness, layout, originality.
 2. The organizers provide prizes and distinctions in every category.
 3. The information about the competition and the results will be published on the school website in January 2018. The winners of the competition will be notified by e-mail or by phone.
 4. The projects submitted for the competition shall be the property of the organisers and are not returnable.
 5. The participation in the competition confirms the acceptance of the contest regulations and the organisers are given the approval to present and reproduce the works using personal data included in the Participants' Card.
