RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING PAUL I. B. STANISZEWSKI SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- 1. The Scholarship Fund is established from a donation of PLN 70,000 (seventy thousand Polish Zloty) made to The John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (KUL) by Justice Paul I. B. Staniszewski ("Founder").
- 2. The aforementioned donation amount shall be placed in a long-term bank account providing high interest rate.
- 3. Interest from the account shall be used for Scholarships.
- 4. Scholarships shall be awarded to outstanding students and doctoral students (members of doctoral school) of Polish Studies (Polish Philology) at KUL who are in need of material support. The major eligibility criteria shall be high academic scores and difficult material standing. Preference shall be given to students who participate in courses in ethics and contemporary Polish history. Participation in extra-curricular initiatives may be used as an auxiliary eligibility criterion.
- 5. Scholarship holders shall write reports on their research advancement to the Founder.
- 5. Scholarships shall be awarded from the second year of study onwards. Scholarship may be withdrawn in the event of failure to complete a semester or an academic year, or on withdrawal from studies.
- 6. The decision to award Scholarship is made by the Commission for Funded Scholarships, chaired by Vice-rector for student support.
