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#### CONCEPT OF PERSON IN THE HANS EDUARD HENGSTENBERG'S ANTHROPOLOGY

##### Summary

The article discuss the anthropological issue of Scheler's most successful pupil, Hans Eduard Hengstenberg. The German philosopher tried to unite two different philosophical traditions: phenomenology and classical metaphysics. His main achievement was foundation of the new anthropological position based on the phenomenological concept of *Sachlichkeit* and the ontology of constitution. The article explains the inner logic of Hengstenberg's ontological position and exams his philosophical criticism against the traditional hylemorphic theory of Aristotle used as a scholastic tool for explaining the union between body and mind.
