Programme Contents (description of the contents of the seminar)		
the contents of the seminar are determined by MA theses. It is assumed that each member becomes a specialist in his or her area. Students inform about their interests, and then report on the results of their quest, studies, analyses, and interpretations.		
Didactic Methods*		
Students prepare their own presentations which are then discussed. The tutor will also present short lectures at the seminar.

Assessment of the student*		
1.	Student receives a credit (without a mark) as a result of his/her systematic work. He/she receives a credit after the first semester on condition that a topic of the thesis is formulated (before mid-December), he/she reports on technical literature and submits a tentative plan of the thesis. The 2nd semester is granted credit if 1/3 of the thesis is submitted before mid-May. The 3rd semester is granted credit if further 1/3 of the thesis is submitted until the end of November, and the 4th semester is given credit when the whole thesis is submitted before the end of April.
