<i>Short characteristics of discipline (about 5 sentences)</i>	<p>Faculty of Theology offers four-years doctoral studies of systematic theology in English. The studies are offered to the foreign students having a Master diploma in theology (or equivalent, according to Polish law and canon law of the Catholic Church).</p> <p>Studies in the doctoral course of systematic theology deepen general knowledge in humanities, provide profound knowledge of Christianity and Roman Catholic doctrine, especially of the Catholic faith from historical, biblical, dogmatic-doctrinal, moral, spiritual, ecumenical and fundamental-theological perspectives. A graduate is prepared for independent research and scholar work in the field of Catholic theology. Possesses adequate competences to fulfill various tasks in the Church and society in the domain of transmitting the faith, organizing of pastoral and charity work, and other tasks belonging to the mission of the Catholic Church. A graduate after having defended a doctoral thesis obtains a diploma of “Theology Doctor” and is prepared to lecture in various fields of systematic theology.</p>
