D_W01	possesses deepened humanistic knowledge, especially in history, literature and art
D_W02	possesses profound theological knowledge, based on the knowledge of the Holy Scripture, patristic and history of the Church
D_W03	knows main currents of Church teaching, especially in chosen specialisation
D_W04	knows the links between theology and philosophy and with other human sciences
D_W05	knows methodology of theology, with special focus on chosen specialisation
D_W06	is well informed about the actual state of knowledge in specialisation in the field in which prepare the doctoral thesis

D_U02	possesses his/her own research skills enabling to undertake and solve on his/her own the scholar issues
D_U03	is able to plan the research in theology, to foresee its results and analyse gathered data
D_U04	is able to search, analyse, evaluate, select and integrate information coming from various sources and formulate critical opinions on this basis
D_U05	is able to use the data bases of scientific information (bibliographies), to prepare and manage it
D_U06	is able to integrate knowledge from various disciplines of science and assess its substantive and methodological value
D_U07	possesses sufficient skills to lead the research and present its results in the form of doctoral dissertation
D_U08	possesses the skills of creating and/or editing the scientific text on the level acceptable to reviewed periodicals
