Course content

The classes will analyze various types of civil proceedings in family matters - incl. matters relating to parental responsibility, contat the child, adoption, alimony and the establishment of custody. Students in class will solve case studies, prepare pleadings, analyze legal acts and scientific publications on family law issues. Finally, students will prepare a presentation on the topic of their choice to be discussed in class.
