Along with the photographic responsibilities the candidate will be in charge of ABA ART LAB's graphic design; developing the current content/layout of corporate website and the production of an art catalogue. As well as sustaining ABA ART LAB's presence with content across all social media platforms, he/she will also be involved with the technical and graphical aspects of maintaining the brand identities consistency (especially across the web site, social media and art catalogue edition).
