

RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE POTULICKA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

/The Rules and Regulations were adopted by Resolution No. 74/2014 of the Board of Directors of the Potulicka Foundation of 16 September 2014/

§ 1

The aim of the Potulicka Foundation Scholarship is to provide material support for the students of the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (KUL) in the spirit of Countess Aniela Potulicka's charitable endeavours.

§ 2

The scholarship ("Scholarship) is dedicated to full-time students of KUL, irrespective of their field of study and level of education (first and second degree as well as long-cycle Master's).

§ 3

The Potulicka Foundation awards each academic year, beginning with the 2014/2015 academic year, a maximum of three Scholarships in the amount not exceeding PLN 3,800 (say: three thousand eight hundred PLN) per year, paid out over nine months.)

§ 4

Students applying for the Potulicka Foundation Scholarship should cumulatively meet the following criteria:

(a) come from rural areas;

(b) come from families with many children (at least three children in the family);

(c) demonstrate low income;

(d) demonstrate good academic results - the grade point average for the previous academic year should be at least 4.000, and in the case of first-year students of first-cycle studies or of long-cycle Master's, the criterion is the average grade on the secondary school final examination certificate.

§ 5

The Potulicka Foundation Scholarship is awarded regardless of any other scholarships, grants or reliefs held or used by an applicant.

§ 6

1. Scholarship is awarded by Vice-rector of KUL for Student Support on behalf of the Potulicka Foundation in consultation with the University Commission for Didactics and Education.

2. The financial means for a given academic year are transferred by the Potulicka Foundation to KUL on receiving information about the number and amount of granted scholarships.
